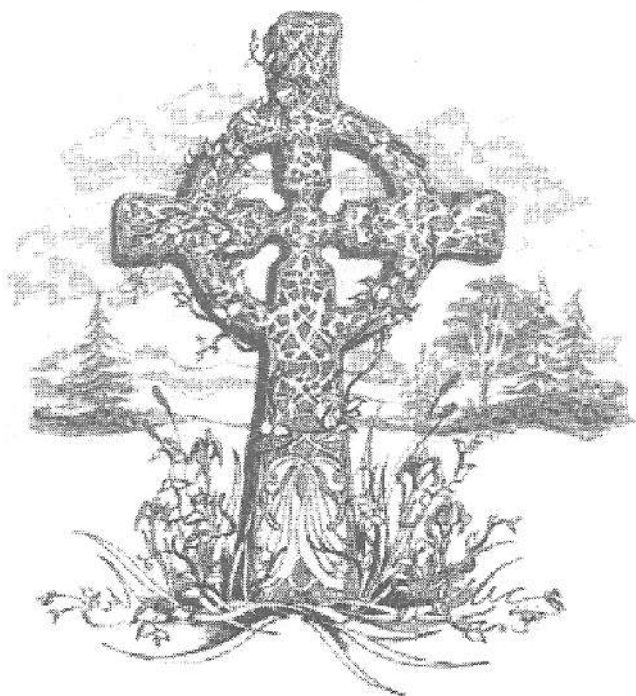

**Did you recently become engaged and want to get married?**



Couples planning to be married must contact a Priest one year in advance. They must also receive personal preparation before entering marriage. If either party has previously gone

through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the Priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's Office has been consulted. If you wish to speak to Fr. Keith, simply call the office and book an appointment.



**Holy Baptism**  
Baptism is the first and most important Sacrament as it opens the door to Christ and His family. It begins forever one's Catholic life in Christ. Because a child is totally dependent in its parents to be its models and first teachers, during the Baptism ceremony the parents commit themselves before God to bring their child up in the practice of Faith. Thus, it is important for parents to come together and prepare with care and prayer. Baptisms are by appointment only and you **MUST** be registered here. To arrange a baptism you must call the Rectory and arrange an appointment with Fr. Keith.

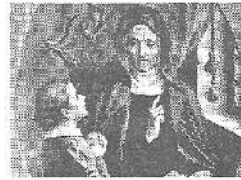

**Saints of the Week**



**Saint Angela Merici:** *Angela Merici is recognized as the founder of the Ursulines. Born in 1474 near Brescis, Italy, she and her sister were orphaned as teens. When Angela's sister,*

*Giana Maria, died suddenly, Angela became a Franciscan tertiary, praying fervently for the repose of her sister's soul. Angela died in 1540. In 1544, the Company of Saint Ursula was officially recognized by Pope Paul III. She is the patron saint of those who have lost parents, who are sick, and who are physically challenged.*

**Saint Thomas Aquinas:** *Saint Thomas Aquinas is one of the greatest minds in the history of the Church. He was born near Aquino, Italy, about 1225. From an early age he posed questions of great theological depth; his family sent him at the age of five to be educated by the Benedictines in Monte Cassino. He died in 1274, was canonized in 1323, and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1567. In 1880, he was proclaimed a patron saint of universities and schools.*



**Saint John Bosco:** *Known as the patron saint of youth he was born in Piedmont, Italy, in 1815. Raised in poverty, John was ordained in Turin in 1841. After witnessing the circumstances of*

*boys living in a local prison, he resolved to devote himself to working among disadvantaged boys, children living on the street, juvenile delinquents, and any child who was suffering. He formed the Salesian Society, named after Francis de Sales, and began educating poor and working class boys. John Bosco died in 1888 and was canonized in 1934.*
